Open Enrollment Transportation Fee

The board reviewed the fee charged for open enrolled student transportation on school buses. Taylor moved to keep the open enrollment transportation fee at \$50/student for the 2025-26 school year. Van Sickle seconded. Motion carried 5-0. Students must meet eligibility requirements to receive transportation services.

Board calendar was reviewed. Supt. Heyer discussed the back to school teacher schedule, provided an update on the elementary roof replacement project, and an update on the safety glass installation project.
