

Minutes of a Regular Meeting of
The Board of Directors of the Ogden Community School District
June 8, 2026

CALL TO ORDER

The Ogden Board of Education held a regular board meeting Monday, June 8, 2026 in the Middle & High School Library. Members Lauren Britton, Kelly Merritt, Earl Taylor, and Matt Van Sickle were present. Pete Thomsen was absent. The meeting was called to order by President Merritt at 6:00pm. Others present were Superintendent Joshua Heyer, Board Secretary Melissa Atwell, Principal Amy Krause, and 15 guests.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Van Sickle moved to approve the agenda. Britton seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Principal Amy Krause recognized three elementary students that received National Math Star awards by scoring in the top 2% of students in the state on ISASP tests: Talia Baitinger, Caden Erickson, and Henry Armstrong.

ACTION ITEMS

Construction Project

Rachelle Hines and Jessy Muo from FRK presented updated designs and renderings for the elementary remodel project. Britton moved to approve the resolution tentatively approving the plans, specifications, form of contract and estimated total cost for the Ogden Community School Renovation to Ogden Elementary Project; setting the time, date, and location for a public hearing on the project; and authorizing the posting of a notice seeking competitive bids for the project. Van Sickle seconded. Motion carried 4-0. A public hearing will be held July 27th at 6pm in the MS/HS Library.

Milk and Bread Bids

Britton moved to approve the milk bid from Anderson Erickson and bread bid from Pan-O-Gold for the 2026-27 school year. Van Sickle seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Equipment Break/Fix Insurance

Taylor moved to approve the SU Insurance Company break fix insurance renewal for \$41,944. Britton seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

2026-27 Employee Handbook

Taylor moved to approve the 2026-27 employee handbook. Britton seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

2026-27 Student Handbooks

Britton moved to approve the 2026-27 Preschool, Elementary, and Middle/High School student handbooks. Van Sickle seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

2026-27 Meal Prices

Britton moved to approve the 2026-27 meal prices. Taylor seconded. Motion carried 4-0. Student lunch, breakfast, extra main dishes, and adult breakfast were increased 10¢. Adult lunches were increased 15¢.

Summer Band Lesson Fee

Britton moved to approve the summer band lesson fee of \$40. Van Sickle seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

Policy Revisions

Britton moved to approve the first reading of revised policies 206.3, 206.4, 701.2, 701.3, 701.5, 704.2, and 704.3 and the first and final reading of policies 203 and 507.9R1. Van Sickle seconded. Motion carried 4-0.

COMMUNICATIONS, DELEGATIONS & PETITIONS

The board calendar was reviewed. Supt. Heyer discussed a potential community meet and greet for the new therapy dogs later this summer and an AI readiness update.

There was no further business to come before the board for consideration. Britton moved to adjourn. Taylor seconded. Motion carried 4-0. President Merritt adjourned the meeting at 7:00pm.
